### APPLICATION DATES – SPRING 2022 PROGRAM

- Application process begins April 1
- Application deadline is August 1
- Supporting documents due September 1
- Fall mid-term grades due October 29
- Program decisions made by November 15
- Program starts each spring semester

### DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT

- Heartland Community College application
- Physical Therapist Assistant application
- Official college transcript(s) listing pre-admission courses
- Copy of driver's license or State ID

**The PTA program at Heartland Community College leads to an Associate in Applied Science Degree in Physical Therapist Assistant. This degree contains pre-admission (general education) courses, PTA technical courses and practical clinical experiences.**

**Pre-admission courses must be completed with a "C" or higher or in progress during the fall semester of the application deadline. A GPA of 2.5 is required in these courses.**

- BIOL 181 – Anatomy & Physiology I (*completed within the last five years*)
- BIOL 182 – Anatomy & Physiology II (*completed within the last five years*)
- COMM 101 – Introduction to Oral Communication
- ENGL 101 – Critical Reading & Writing
- HLTH 225 – Clinical Kinesiology (*completed within the last five years*)
- PSY 101 – Introduction to Psychology
- PSY 209 – Human Growth & Development

\*AP exam credit will be scored as follows: 5 = letter grade A; 4 = letter grade B; 3 = letter grade C. Scores below 3 will not be considered for PTA admission.

\*If a transcript utilized in the application process has a Credit or Pass in lieu of a letter grade for a required program prerequisite course taken during or after January 2020, HCC will verify that the Credit or Pass equated to a letter grade C. If the Credit or Pass does not meet this standard, that course will not be accepted as passed. This provision shall only be allowed when there is documented evidence this grading policy related to Credit or Pass is in effect. HCC reserves all rights in determination of utilization of letter grades versus other grading mechanisms

**Minimum comprehensive score of 59.4% is required on the ATI TEAS.**

- The ATI TEAS will be offered between April and August at Heartland and can be retaken one time within the application period. The highest grade within the application period will be used for evaluation. See dates and how to make an appointment at <https://www.heartland.edu/pta/events.html>. **Residency Requirement**

- Applicants who are legal residents of Community College District #540 (as proven by driver’s license or State ID) will be given preference for admission provided all admission criteria are met. A maximum of two qualified applicants who are out of district that are ranked in the top 16 will be offered a seat in the program.
