What to Bring

1. A short write-up (one page, **maximum**) describing some teaching innovation you have observed, experienced as a learner, or used as a teacher. Please bring 10 copies.
2. A short description (maybe a half page in length) that tells of a problem in teaching that you have not been able to solve. Please bring 10 copies of this as well; they may be on the same page as the innovation write-up.
3. A “trick of the trade” or some little thing that makes your life as a teacher easier. GTR facilitators sometimes refer to this as a “non-astounding teaching device.” It may be something you use in the classroom, but it also may be something that helps with organization or with the sea of paperwork.
4. A book that has had an influence on your teaching. It may be, but does not need to be, in your content area and it certainly does not need to be a textbook.
