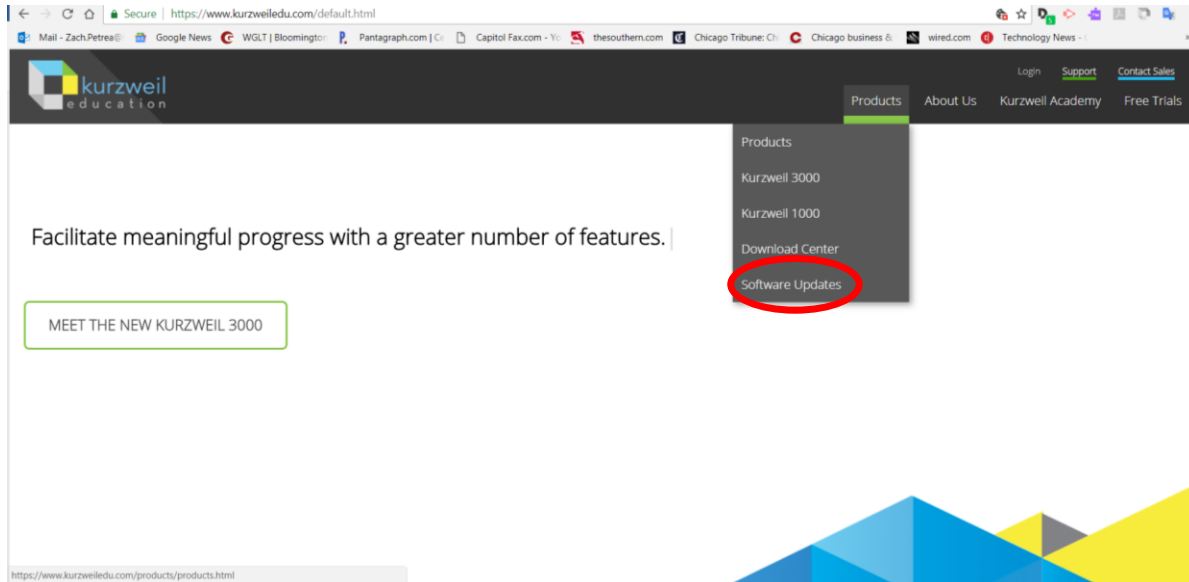


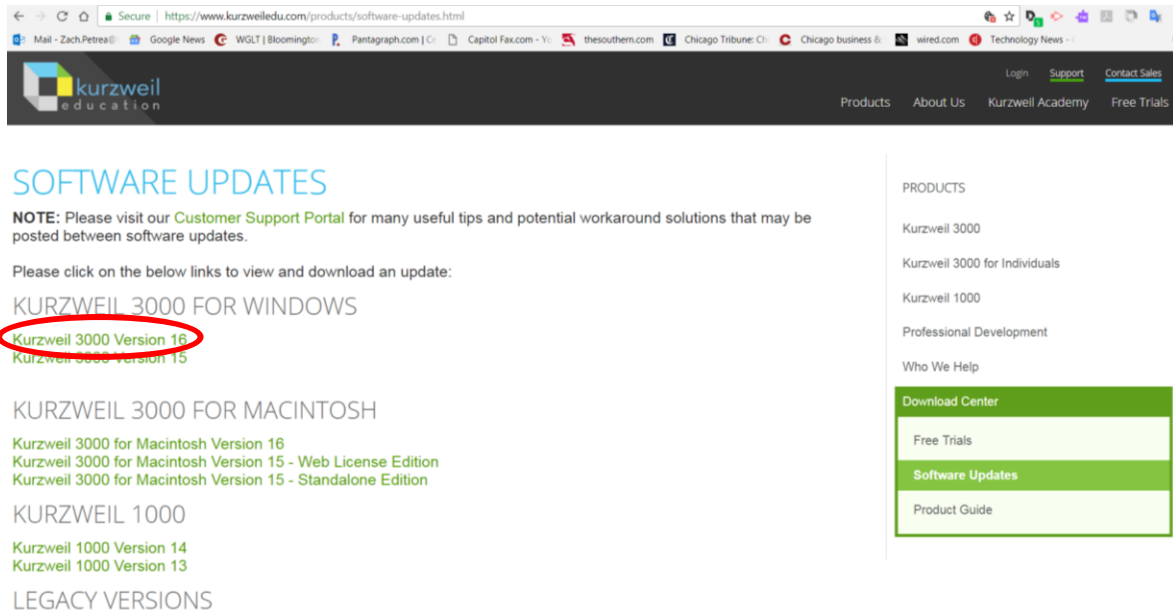
KURZWEIL 3000 DESKTOP INSTALLATION

This guide will identify the steps required to download and install the desktop version of Kurzweil 3000 for Windows.

1. Go to <https://www.kurzweiledu.com>
2. Choose “**Products**” and select “**Software Updates**”



3. Select the most recent version of K3000



4. Download the installer
