Part-Day = less than 5 hours, between 7:30 - 1:00

Full-Day = 5 or more hours between 7:30 - 5:00

Sibling Discount: 10% discount will apply to the oldest child

1. Tuition Fees are billed monthly.
 - Tuition Fees apply for days that classrooms are open.
 - Tuition Fees are NOT applied for days classrooms are closed (i.e. breaks, holidays, weather, etc.).
 - Tuition Fees ARE applied if a child is absent on a day the child is scheduled (i.e. illness, vacation, etc.).
2. Requests for changes to a child's schedule must be submitted in writing in advance of the change, and must be approved by the director or program assistant.
3. Two-week's written notice is required for cancelling child care. Tuition Fees will continue to accrue until the conclusion of the two-week period, regardless of attendance.
4. Late Fees are charged for children left in the Center after their scheduled pick-up time, beginning at 1 minute past the child's scheduled time. Late Fees will be added to monthly statements.
5. Account balances are to be paid at the cashier's desk in the Community Commons Building or by calling (309) 268-8140 for credit card payments. Payments are due by the 15th of the month and will be considered delinquent at the end of the month.
6. Delinquent accounts will be monitored by the Business Office, and may be turned over to collections. Children will not be able to attend the CDL until the past-due balances are paid in full. HCC students may be unable to register for classes until past-due balances are paid.
