- **Data Manipulation** (Final Cut Pro, ArcGIS, turning drone images into 3D maps, etc.)
- **Drone Essentials** (ethics and law, repair, insurance, etc.)

Each breakout session is 45 minutes long. You should plan to present 30 minutes of content, with 15 additional minutes for Q&A. Audience size will vary from 20 to 50 participants per breakout session, some of which will be repeated.
