When contacting one of these sites to arrange an observation, field experience, or application assignment, the following are some general guidelines:

- 1. Identify yourself as a Heartland Community College student enrolled in _____ course. Briefly explain the purpose of your assignment.
- 2. Identify the amount of time that you will be need to be at the program and the age group you would like to be placed with.
- 3. Provide specific information about your assignment. For example, will you be directly interacting with the children? Observing? Interviewing a teacher?
- 4. Set up the time and date for your visit, and remember to be punctual.
- 5. Thank the person who arranged the visit for their time.

Remember when you conduct your visit that you are representing the college and early childhood field. You need to dress and represent yourself as a professional. While comfortable clothes are acceptable, your attire should also be clean and presentable.
