APPLICATION DATES – SUMMER 2022 PROGRAM

- Application process begins September 1
- Application deadline is January 1
- Supporting documents due January 15
- Program decisions made February 15 – March 15
- Program starts each summer semester

DOCUMENTS TO SUBMIT

- Heartland Community College application
- Radiography application
- Official high school & college transcripts
- Copy of driver's license or State ID (preference given to in district applicants)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Priority #1 - These are prerequisites to applying for the program. They must be completed by January 15.

- Place at the college-level in math and literacy (*Based on placement scores or prior coursework*)
- Meet the prerequisite for BIOL 181 **or** show completion of BIOL 181 or equivalent (*no expiration*)
- Meet the minimum GPA of 2.5 or higher in **all** prior college level coursework
- Meet the core GPA of 2.5 (includes ENGL 101, college-level math, BIOL 181, BIOL 182)
- Complete the ATI TEAS. The ATI TEAS will be offered between September and December through Heartland. Appointments can be made through home.heartland.edu. Study guides are available at <https://atitesting.com/teas-prep> or the HCC Library.

Priority #2 - These are the general education courses that are required as a part of the radiography program. They are not required to be completed prior to applying, but they can improve your application when completed with a "C" or higher grade. **Minimum GPA among these courses must be a 2.5 minimum.**

- BIOL 181 – Anatomy & Physiology I
- BIOL 182 – Anatomy & Physiology II
- ENGL 101 – Critical Reading & Writing
- HLTH 110 – Medical Terminology
- Any college-level math course (*excludes tech math*)

Priority #3 - These courses are not required for the Heartland radiography program. However, they may earn you additional points toward your application (when completed with a "C" or better) if all the radiography general education courses (Priority #2) are completed.
