CLINICAL SITES

Each clinical setting will expose the student to different types of management, department organization, personnel, technologies, equipment, projections, and procedures. Students will travel and rotate through majority of the clinical sites for varying intervals over the course of the two-year program.

Carle Bromenn Medical Center - Normal and OSF St. Joseph Medical Center - Bloomington are our main clinical sites and students will be required to rotate through both sites.

CLINICAL OBLIGATIONS

- Clinical rotations are generally between the hours of 7:30am-4:00pm
- 2 or more weeks of 2nd shift per semester between 2:30pm-11:00pm
- Weekends (day shift Saturday and Sunday) during 3rd thru 6th semesters
- 3 nights of 3rd shift (Sunday through Thursday) during the final semester
- Rotation through appropriate clinical site to ensure all patient care competencies are met
