

Steps to Enroll

- 1. Apply to Heartland
- 2. Submit Transcripts
- 3. Take (or waive) Literacy Placement Test
- 4. Meet with an Advisor to Register



Requirements

- All students must provide COVID vaccination card documenting completion of the vaccine, unless you can provide a professional medical or professional religious exemption.
- Submit copies of photo ID <u>and</u> social security card (SSN) or individual tax identification number (ITIN) by Wednesday, August 6.
- Attend mandatory orientation: Wednesday, August 13.
- Attend mandatory fingerprinting: Friday, August 15.
- A physical and TB test are required at the student's expense.
