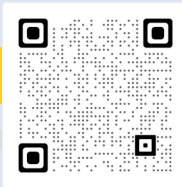


Funding Options

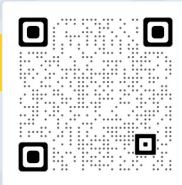

Check your eligibility for funding through the Land of Lincoln Workforce Alliance.

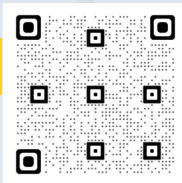
