

Steps to Enroll

1. Apply to Heartland
2. Submit Transcripts (high school/college)
3. Take (or waive) Literacy Placement Test
4. Meet with an Advisor to Register



APPLY



CNAs provide basic care for patients in hospitals, long-term care centers and in private homes.

Requirements

- Submit copies of photo ID and social security card (SSN) by **Thursday, December 18.**
- Attend mandatory orientation: Wednesday, January 7 from 9am-1pm.
*Failure to attend will result in being dropped from the course.
- Attend mandatory fingerprinting: Friday, January 9. (in Bloomington)

Students must submit to authorization for a Live Scan fingerprint (required by Illinois law); a physical exam, TB testing; uniform purchase, and must have personal health insurance coverage. Clinical sites may have additional requirements to which students in this course must adhere, including vaccinations. NURS 110 meets federal and state guidelines for nursing assistant training, and students who successfully complete this course will be eligible to take the state competency exam required for nursing assistants.
