- Self-paced.
- Flexible, individualized instruction.
- Ideal for students who are self-motivated.
- Need good time-management skills.
- Students can finish their course at any time during the semester.
- Offer a unique blend of traditional and online courses.
- You will work independently but still have access to one-on-one instruction and assistance.
 through the in-person or virtual lab hours on Zoom.
- NO set due dates with the exception for midterm (March 10th) and end of the semester (May 12th at 11:59 pm).
- Access to a lab facilitator either in person or via Zoom.
- Assignments will be submitted in Canvas.

Success Strategies for Open Learning Students

- Self-schedule time each week to work on their Open Learning course.
- Comfortable using a computer.
- Check e-mail regularly.
- Have Internet access and a computer at home.
- Regularly use the Zoom link for help.

Open Learning FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

How much time will I have to spend each week working on an Open Learning course?

- The amount of time you spend each week is up to you.
- You can finish the course in a few weeks, a month, or throughout the entire semester.
- Make sure to pace yourself so you have all assignments completed by May 12th at 11:59pm

How long will it take me to finish an Open Learning course?

- The time is up to you.
- Most Open Learning courses could easily be finished within four to eight weeks.
- You may take the full 16 weeks to complete if needed.
- All course requirements must be completed by the end of the semester.

Will I ever see my instructor?

- All instructors who teach an Open Learning course work in the BTLC.
- Your instructor posted when they are working in the lab in your syllabus.
- You can make an appointment to see your instructor in the BTLC or on Zoom.

What computer skills do I need to be successful in the OL classes?

- Basic Internet skills
- Basic keyboarding skills
- Simple working knowledge of Word.
- File management skills such as saving and retrieving files.
- RELAX the facilitators are available to help you!

Do I need to have a computer at home?

- You should have access to a computer other than on campus.
- Your computer needs the Windows operating system (non-Mac) for the courses.
- You will need access to Microsoft Office programs.

How will I turn in my homework?

- Open Learning courses use Canvas.
- Canvas is an online learning management system.
- All assignments will be found and submitted on Canvas via the Internet.

This sounds overwhelming. Are there deadlines?

- See your course syllabus for the assignment due dates.
- You are expected to complete the assignments on your own in your own time.
- ALL assignments need to be completed by the end of the semester.
- Do not Procrastinate!

The semester has already started, can I still register?

YES – registration for Open Learning classes is open until April 10^{th.}

Do I need to buy a textbook?

- Many CTEC and OTEC classes require an access code.
- BTEC 145 Employment Success Strategies and OTEC 104 Office Simulation do <u>not</u> require a textbook.
- To save on the cost we use Cengage Unlimited.
- Available options will be explained at orientation.
- DO NOT purchase until you have attended an orientation.
