Articulation Transfer Agreement Between Millikin University

Heartland Community College

Heartland Community College (Heartland) and Millikin University (Millikin) form a cooperative relationship through this articulation agreement to better serve our public constituents, to ease the transfer process, to minimize duplication of instruction, and to build upon community college and university learning experiences. Both institutions recognize that by working together, their collective efforts are stronger than their individual efforts. The agreement is twofold: students who wish to earn a Millikin degree will be provided with a timely four-year plan, as well as automatic acceptance into the Millikin baccalaureate degree programs.

The two institutions agree to the following:

- 1. Any student who has completed an Associate in Arts, Associate in Science, or Associate in Engineering Science and the necessary courses as outlined in Appendix A (with the required 2.0 GPA) and who submits the required application and supporting documentation will automatically be admitted to Millikin University and be able to complete their program requirements in 2 years/4 semesters (assuming fulltime enrollment of approximately 12-18 credits each semester). Students transferring with a completed AA, AS, or AES will have satisfied all University Studies/General Education and College distribution requirements.
- 2. Acceptance as a Millikin student does not preclude the individual student from meeting the specific core requirements or criteria listed for specific programs.
- Relationships between Heartland and Millikin faculty and administration are in the spirit of cooperation and provide the basis for this agreement.
- Representatives of both institutions agree to meet at least biennially to assess curricular changes and other conditions that may affect the purpose of this agreement and/or to develop a new 2+2 agreement.
- 5. This agreement does not preclude either institution from making curriculum changes as it may solely deem appropriate, in which case, appropriate prior notice will be given to the operative academic personnel at the cooperating institution.
- Appropriate publications and promotional materials regarding this agreement will be made available to all Heartland students. Both institutions will also highlight this agreement on their respective websites.
- 7. Any Heartland graduates that have successfully completed the requirements of the Honors Program will be automatically accepted into Millikin's James Millikin Honors Scholars program upon application.
- 8. Any international students who have completed their AA or AS degree with the required 2.0 GPA and who submits the required application and supporting documents pertaining to their visa category will also be automatically admitted to Millikin University. International students are guaranteed a base tuition rate no higher than that of domestic students, and will also be eligible for merit scholarships.
- Either Millikin or Heartland may dissolve this agreement by giving advanced written notice of one year.

- 10. This agreement will be reviewed at least biennially and will be in effect for two years. Modifications to this agreement must be agreed upon by both Heartland and Millikin. This agreement will be automatically renewed unless terminated by Heartland or Millikin. This agreement is effective beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year.
- 11. This agreement shall not replace or supersede any other agreement Millikin and Heartland may have.

Reverse Transfer Agreement Between Millikin University And Heartland Community College

Millikin University (Millikin) and Heartland Community College (Heartland) to facilitate the advisement and transfer of students and provide a seamless transfer process between the two institutions have agreed to the following principles of cooperation and coordination:

- Millikin understands and values Heartland's mission of educating the population of its surrounding district and of awarding two-year associate degrees. The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transfer of specified coursework from Millikin to Heartland to complete requirements for the associate degree. This process is called a reverse transfer or reverse articulation.
- 2. Students enrolled at Millikin who (1) previously attended Heartland or are currently enrolled at Heartland and (2) meet Heartland's residency requirement of 15 credit hours may be eligible for reverse transfer credit toward a Heartland associate degree.
- 3. Separate academic records for students will be maintained at each institution.
- 4. Millikin and Heartland agree to exchange transfer student information for the purpose of monitoring and promoting student academic success and degree conferral.
 - a. For students admitted to and enrolled at Millikin with a minimum of 15 transfer credits, Millikin will notify those students who previously attended Heartland but never completed their associate degree at Heartland about this agreement and ask if the student would like to sign a reverse transfer transcript request/release form (RTTR/R) to allow Millikin to send their Millikin transcript to Heartland for further review. This process will start upon signature of this agreement.
 - b. Upon receipt of a signed RTTR/R, Millikin will forward a transcript at the end of each consecutive term in which the student earns hours at Millikin to the Registrar at Heartland who will review the Millikin transcript and verify if the student completed an associate degree based on coursework already completed at Heartland and Millikin. A copy of the RTTR/R will accompany each transcript, identifying it as belonging to a reverse transfer student. There will be no cost to the student for these transcripts. If there is a break in attendance at Millikin, the student will need to submit a new RTTR/R when they re-enrolls at Millikin.
- 5. Pursuant to this agreement, Millikin will send transcripts of continuing Millikin students to Heartland on an ongoing basis. Heartland will evaluate all coursework that may assist in the completion of the

student's associate degree at Heartland. A student who meets all Heartland associate degree requirements will be eligible to receive an associate degree posted to the transcript at no additional cost to the student. Heartland will notify students who are eligible to receive an associate degree. Once required coursework for a Heartland degree is complete, Heartland will notify Millikin to discontinue sending transcripts by sending Millikin a Heartland transcript with the degree posted, accompanied by a copy of the signed RTTR/R. There will be no cost to the student for this transcript.

- 6. Millikin and Heartland agree to promptly communicate with each other regarding any future curriculum changes, policy changes, or resident credit requirements that will affect the term and intent of this agreement.
- 7. Heartland's Registrar and Millikin's University Registrar will serve as the point of contact for administration of this agreement.
- 8. This agreement will be reviewed at least biennially and will be in effect for two years. Modifications to this agreement must be agreed upon by both Heartland and Millikin. This agreement will be automatically renewed unless terminated by Heartland or Millikin. This agreement is effective beginning with the 2024-2025 academic year.
